

IRREGULAR VERBS : **eō, ire** (*go*); **ferō, ferre, tulī, lātum** (*bring, bear, carry, say*) : indicative and **subjunctive**
 These verbs frequently appear in compound forms, e.g. **abeō, referō**, etc.

PRESENT ACTIVE

<i>I</i>	eō	eam	ferō	feram

<i>s/he, it</i>	ībat	īret	ferēbat	ferret
<i>we</i>	ībāmus	īrēmus	ferēbāmus	ferrēmus
<i>you (p.)</i>	ībātis	īrētis	ferēbātis	ferrētis
<i>they</i>	ībant	īrent	ferēbant	ferrent

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PERFECT ACTIVE

<i>I</i>	īī (or īvī)*	ierim (or īverim)*	tulī	tulerim
<i>you (s.)</i>	īstī (or -iistī)	ierīs	tulistī	tulerīs
<i>s/he, it</i>	īit	ierit	tulit	tulerit
<i>we</i>	īimus	ierīmus	tulimus	tulerīmus
<i>you (p.)</i>	īstis (or -iistī)	ierītis	tulistis	tulerītis
<i>they</i>	īērunt (īēre)	ierint	tulērunt (tulēre)	tulerint

FUTURE PERFECT ACTIVE (no future perfect subjunctive)

<i>I</i>	ierō (or īverō)*	tulerō
<i>you (s.)</i>	ieris	tuleris
<i>s/he, it</i>	ierit	tulerit
<i>we</i>	ierimus	tulerimus
<i>you (p.)</i>	ieritis	tuleritis
<i>they</i>	ierint	tulerint

PLUPERFECT ACTIVE

<i>I</i>	ieram (or īveram)*	īssēm (or iissem or īvissem)*	tuleram	tulissēm
<i>you (s.)</i>	ierās	īssēs	tulerās	tulissēs
<i>s/he, it</i>	ierat	īssēt	tulerat	tulisset
<i>we</i>	ierāmus	īssēmus	tulerāmus	tulissēmus
<i>you (p.)</i>	ierātis	īssētis	tulerātis	tulissētis
<i>they</i>	ierant	īssent	tulerant	tulissent

* These alternative endings may appear in any of the six persons (*I, you, she*, etc).

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PRESENT PASSIVE

<i>I</i>	<i>To go</i> does not have a passive in English.* However, eō, īre does appear in the passive, impersonally, in the 3 rd person singular present (itur) and perfect, itum est , meaning <i>there is/was a going</i> , i.e. <i>people</i> (or whoever is mentioned) <i>go</i> .	feror	ferar	fertur and feruntur (and ferunt in the active) often mean <i>say, report</i> : i.e., <i>is said, are said, they say</i>

FUTURE PASSIVE (no future subjunctive)

<i>I</i>	ferar
<i>you (s.)</i>	ferēris (-re)
<i>s/he, it</i>	ferētur
<i>we</i>	ferēmur
<i>you (p.)</i>	ferēminī
<i>they</i>	ferentur

IMPERFECT PASSIVE

<i>I</i>	ferēbar	ferrer
<i>you (s.)</i>	ferēbāris (-re)	ferrēris (-re)
<i>s/he, it</i>	ferēbātur	ferrētur
<i>we</i>	ferēbāmur	ferrēmur
<i>you (p.)</i>	ferēbāminī	ferrēminī
<i>they</i>	ferēbāntur	ferrentur

* Many compounds of intransitive verbs are transitive (i.e. take direct objects), and therefore appear in the passive; e.g. **adeō, īre** (*approach, enter on, undertake*)

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PERFECT PASSIVE

<i>I</i>	<i>lātus/a sum</i>	<i>lātus/a sim</i>
<i>you (s.)</i>	<i>lātus/a es</i>	<i>lātus/a sīs</i>
<i>s/he, it</i>	<i>lātus/a est</i>	<i>lātus/a sit</i>
<i>we</i>	<i>lātī/ae sumus</i>	<i>lātī/ae sīmus</i>
<i>you (p.)</i>	<i>lātī/ae estis</i>	<i>lātī/ae sītis</i>
<i>they</i>	<i>lātī/ae sunt</i>	<i>lātī/ae sint</i>

FUTURE PERFECT PASSIVE (no future perfect subjunctive)

<i>I</i>	<i>lātus/a erō</i>
<i>you (s.)</i>	<i>lātus/a eris</i>
<i>s/he, it</i>	<i>lātus/a erit</i>
<i>we</i>	<i>lātī/ae erimus</i>
<i>you (p.)</i>	<i>lātī/ae eritis</i>
<i>they</i>	<i>lātī/ae erunt</i>

PLUPERFECT PASSIVE
