

IRREGULAR VERBS A : **sum, esse; possum, posse; fiō, fierī** (= *become, happen, be made*) :
indicative and **subjunctive** (**sum** and **possum** have no passive; **fiō** serves as the passive of **faciō**)

PRESENT

<i>I</i>	sum	sim	possum	possim	fiō	fiam
<i>you (s.)</i>	es	sīs	potes	possīs	fīs	fiās
<i>s/he, it</i>	est	sit	potest	possit	fīt	fiat

FUTURE (no future subjunctive)

<i>you (p.)</i>	eritis		poteritis		fietis
<i>they</i>	erunt		poterunt		fient

IMPERFECT

<i>I</i>	eram	essem/forem*	poteram	possem	fiēbam	fierem
<i>you (s.)</i>	erās	essēs/forēs	poterās	possēs	fiēbās	fierēs
<i>s/he, it</i>	erat	esset/foret	poterat	posset	fiēbat	fieret
<i>we</i>	erāmus	essēmus/forēmus	poterāmus	possēmus	fiēbāmus	fierēmus
<i>you (p.)</i>	erātis	essētis/forētis	poterātis	possētis	fiēbātis	fierētis
<i>they</i>	erant	essent/forent	poterant	possent	fiēbant	fierent

* **forem, forēs**, etc, may appear as the imperfect subjunctive of **sum, esse** (**fore** is an alternative form of the future infinitive)

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PERFECT

FUTURE PERFECT (no future perfect subjunctive)

<i>I</i>	fuerō	potuerō	factus/a erō
<i>you (s.)</i>	fueris	potueris	factus/a eris
<i>s/he, it</i>	fuerit	potuerit	factus/a erit
<i>we</i>	fuerimus	potuerimus	factī/ae erimus
<i>you (p.)</i>	fueritis	potueritis	factī/ae eritis
<i>they</i>	fuerint	potuerint	factī/ae erunt

PLUPERFECT

<i>I</i>	fueram	fuissem	potueram	potuissem	factus/a eram	factus/a essem
<i>you (s.)</i>	fuerās	fuiissēs	potuerās	potuissēs	factus/a erās	factus/a essēs
<i>s/he, it</i>	fuerat	fuisset	potuerat	potuisset	factus/a erat	factus/a esset
<i>we</i>	fuerāmus	fuiissēmus	potuerāmus	potuissēmus	factī/ae erāmus	factī/ae essēmus
<i>you (p.)</i>	fuerātis	fuiissētis	potuerātis	potuissētis	factī/ae erātis	factī/ae essētis
<i>they</i>	fuerant	fuisent	potuerant	potuissent	factī/ae erant	factī/ae essent
