All these nouns are neuter.

Like **corpus, corporis**
(the stems are not all identical)

crūs, crūris [n.] leg
facinus, facinoris [n.] crime, outrage
frīgus, frīgoris [n.] cold, chill
fūnus, fūneris [n.] death, funeral
genus, generis [n.] race, offspring
iūs, iūris [n.] justice
lītus, lītoris [n.] shore
mūnus, mūneris [n.] gift, service, public show
onus, oneris [n.] burden
opus, operis [n.] work, action, task
ōs, ūris [n.] face, mouth
pectus, pectoris [n.] breast, heart, courage
rūs, rūris [n.] country, land, estate
scelus, sceleris [n.] wicked act, crime
sīdus, sīderis [n.] star, [pl.] sky
tempus, temporis [n.] time
vulnus, vulneris [n.] wound

Like **nōmen, nōminis**:

agmen, agminis [n.] crowd, throng, troop
carmen, carminis [n.] poem, song
certāmen, certāminis [n.] conflict, competition
crīmen,-inis [n.] crime, charge, accusation
flāmen,-inis [m.] flamen, priest
flūmen,-inis [n.] river
fulmen,-inis [n.] thunderbolt
grāmen,-inis [n.] grass
līmen,-inis [n.] threshold, doorway
lūmen,-inis [n.] light, eye
nūmen,-inis [n.] nod, divine will, god

All these nouns are neuter.

Like **cubīle**, **cubīlis**:

mare, **maris** *sea* (the genitive plural appears only once, as **marum**)

Like **animal**, **animālis**:

tribūnal, **tribūnālis** *tribunal*

Notes

1. As with all neuter endings, the nominative and accusative are the same.
2. All neuter plurals in the nominative, vocative and accusative end **-a**.
3. Distinguish between nouns like **corpus** and nouns of the 2nd declension (**servus**) and 4th declension (**currus**).
4. Additional nouns listed are examples only: there are other similar nouns.
